

This document sets out the terms of participation in RAILBLAZA's "Summer Action Photo" competition.

1. The promoter of this Competition is RAILBLAZA Ltd (the "Promoter") 6 Tavern Road, Silverdale, Auckland 0932, New Zealand
2. Entry to the Competition is open to residents of New Zealand and Australia. An entrant must be an individual and not a company or organisation. Entrants under 18 years of age must have the consent of their parent or guardian to enter. Employees of the Promoter or any person associated with the Competition, or any organisation or individual associated with the provision of the prize(s) are not eligible to enter.
3. Each entry must be entered in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. By entering the Competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter may, at its discretion, refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

The prize winner will be contacted within five days of their selection. If the Promoter cannot contact the winner within 14 days of the selection, after having made a reasonable attempt to do so, the Prize will be redrawn.
